PADI Junior Open Water Diver / Open Water Diver. Recognised across the world, and valid for life (or as long as you are physically/mentally able to dive), this truly is your 'passport' to the underwater world allowing you to scuba dive down to 15 metres with a qualified 'Buddy' (juniors must have an adult buddy), Open Water divers (aged 15+ are qualified to dive down to 18 metres with a qualified buddy). This means you can scuba dive wherever your travels take you, you will be trained in safe diving procedures and have a very sound understanding of how to dive both safely and confidently. (Juniors aged 10 to 12 years = max depth 12 metres under direct supervision of PADI Divemaster).

The course involves: 5 x academic modules, 5 x pool training modules, 4 x open water certifying dives. All course materials and equipment are provided for your use in the course price. The course is performance-based meaning we teach at your pace for optimum results.

Requirements:

- Minimum age: 10 years (You will lose your junior status and be permitted to dive to 18 metres when you become 15)
- Must complete a medical questionnaire
- Must be able to swim (Just average swimming ability required, there is a modest swimming assessment)
